The seminar is part of the SEABASED Project, co-financed by Interreg Central Baltic Programme and led by John Nurminen Foundation, in which some of these new measures are examined and piloted. The aim of the project is to produce neutral, science-based knowledge of the effects, costs and risks of the different measures, to be used as a foundation for decision making by actors in the Baltic Sea region. Thus, this seminar and the previous workshops held in Finland and Sweden, aim to collect experts' views that could be utilized in future work during the SEABASED Project, and, also in formulating an international assessment framework in HELCOM (ongoing work in HELCOM ad hoc working group MINUTS).
